MARKET SYNOPSIS

- Auction volumes declined to 5.0 M/Kgs.
- Good general demand.
- Select BOP/BOPF invoices appreciated by Rs. 100 per kg plus for a useful selection of seasonal Westerns which were on offer.
- All-time record price of Rs. 3,050 per kg for a Wester High Grown BOP established by Somerset Estate.
- BOPF grade continued to secure a premium of Rs. 200 per kg and above in most instances vis-à-vis the BOP grade.
- Improved activity from shippers to Iran helps to stabilise Low Grown prices.
