

# Tea Market Report: Sale 23 of 8th - 9th June 2026

There was improved general demand for the 189,274 packages (12.78m/kgs) on offer with 23.92% unsold.

## Leaf Grades (M2 & M3)

**Offerings:** - 113,800 packages (7.60m/kgs) – 33.50% unsold.

### BP1:

**Best** – Irregularly gained by up to USC40.

**Brighter** – Steady to USC20 above previous levels to easier by up to USC9.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were firm to USC18 dearer with plantation mediums easier by up to USC7 but select invoices advanced by up to USC13.

**Lower Medium** – Appreciated by up to USC13.

**Plainer** – Less enquiry and shed by up to USC8.

### PF1:

**Best** – Gained by up to USC13 while some lines were firm to USC6 below previous rates.

**Brighter** – Were irregular and ranged between USC4 dearer to easier by up to USC6.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were irregularly dearer by up to USC8. Plantation mediums were irregular varying between USC6 dearer to easier by up to USC2.

**Lower Medium** – Were firm to dearer by up to USC8.

**Plainer** – About steady to mostly

## Dust Grades (M1)

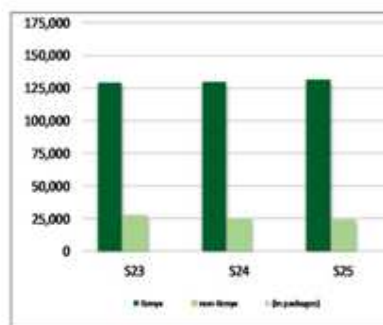
**Offerings:** - 55,160 packages (4.12m/kgs) – 11.09% unsold.

### PDUST:

**Best** – Steady to USC7 above previous rates to easier by up to USC12.

**Brighter** – Held value with some teas up to USC6 dearer to easier by up to USC5.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were irregularly dearer by up to USC11 while plantation mediums saw steady tendencies advancing by up to USC4 to easier by USC2.



**Lower Medium** – Were firm to mostly dearer by up to USC8, some lines however lost by up to USC4  
**Plainer** – Some teas were up to USC10 above previous rates with others firm to easier by up to USC6.
