Tea Market Report: Sale 42 of 14th – 15th October 2024

Fair general demand prevailed in the market for the 157,907 packages (10.73m/kgs) offered; 46.40% were unsold.

The multiple reprint (M4) auction had on offer 131,520 packages (8.97m/kgs) with 89.70% remaining unsold.

Leaf Grades (M2 & M3)

Offerings: 89,159 packages (5.94m/kgs) – 57.48% unsold.

BP1:

Best — Met irregular absorption ranging between USC10 dearer with some lines gaining up to USC150 to easier by USC8 with select teas discounted by up to USC50.

Brighter – Mostly easier by up to USC90 but select Invoices were up to USC11 above previous rates.

Mediums — KTDA mediums were irregularly discounted by up to USC45 while plantation mediums met irregular enquiry ranging between USC5 above last levels for some lines to easier by up to USC10.

Lower Medium – Saw good absorption at easier levels and lost up to USC25 but some lines gained USC14.

Plainer – Were easier by up to USC22.

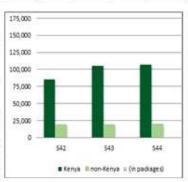
Best – Mostly easier by up to USC36 but select teas gained USC6.

Mediums — KTDA mediums were easier by up to USC52 following the removal of reserve prices while a number of lines remained unsold with plantation mediums irregular ranging between USC15 above previous prices to easier by up to USC18.

Lower Medium – Were easier by up to USC13 but select invoices were USC10 dearer.

Plainer – Irregularly lost up to USC 19 but a few teas were



steady to USC3 dearer.

Offerings: 51,880 packages (3.89m/kgs) – 39.90% unsold.

In the Secondary Catalogues, BPs were about steady while PFs mostly sold at previous rates. Clean well sorted coloury Brighter – Were irregular ranging Families barely held value

while similar DUSTs were irregularly firm. Other Fannings were steady while DUSTs eased. BMFs were well absorbed.

Markets

Pakistan Packers, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries were active at lower levels with Bazaar and Afghanistan less active. Kazakhstan and other CIS states lent more support and were strong while UK maintained enquiry. Egyptian Packers were less active at lower rates with reduced participation from Russia. Sedan were operating with South Sedan less active. China maintained some activity while Local Packers were selective. Somalia continued active at the lower end of the market.
