

Tea Market Report: Sale 37 of 14th - 15th Sep 2026

There was good general demand at irregular levels for the 105,900 packages (7.039m/kgs) available in the market with 17.43% unsold

Leaf Grades (M2 & M3)

Offerings: - 55,040 packages (3.627m/kgs) – 23.26% unsold.

BP1:

Best – Were firm to dearer by up to USC10 but some teas shed by up to a similar margin.

Brighter – Saw irregular support and ranged between USC18 above previous levels to easier by up to USC23.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were mostly advanced by up to USC18 but select lines eased by up to USC9. Plantation mediums were firm to irregularly dearer by up to USC20.

Lower Medium – Were up to USC15 above last rates to irregularly easier by up to USC9.

Plainer – Met less enquiry at USC9 below previous levels.

PF1:

Best – Were up to USC11 dearer to easier by up to USC4.

Brighter – Steady to USC8 dearer to easier by up to USC4.

Mediums – Some KTDA mediums were about firm to USC9 easier while plantation mediums held value to USC7 dearer to easier by up to USC6.

Offerings: - 35,680 packages (2.652m/kgs) – 11.66% unsold.

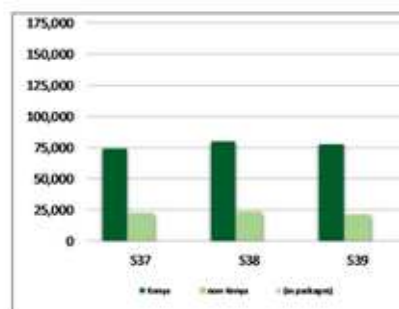
PDUST:

Best – Irregularly appreciated by up to USC53.

Brighter – Steady to USC12 above previous levels.

Mediums – KTDA mediums were dearer by up to USC12 but select lines shed by up to USC13 while plantation mediums gained by up to USC6.
